PREVENTION OF FREE ACCESS TO BUILDING WITHOUT CONTROL

Airport is a public facility and has open access during business hours. Rental car services use main building, the rest of the buildings are leased out. Restricted controlled access to air field.

SINGLE ACCESS POINT FOR VISITORS

Only 1 access point for visitors.

ACCESS CONTROL

UNRESTRICTED PUBLIC ACCESS

-IS THERE ONE CENTRAL ACCESS POINT FOR ALL VISITORS?

-SIGNS RESTRICTING ACCESS TO NONPUBLIC AREAS?

(ALERTS, NO TRESSPASSING, NO PARKING, ETC.)

-IS SOMEONE THERE TO GREET PEOPLE? WHAT IS THE CHECK IN PROCESS?

-IS STAFF TRAINED TO ASK ALL VISITORS, "HOW CAN I HELP YOU?"

Staff is trained on asking visitors.

EMPLOYEE ACCESS

Certain areas open to public, and other offices maintain locked and secured.

DELIVERIES

-DO THEY CHECK IN? WHATS THE PROCESS?

-ARE GATES LEFT OPEN FOR EXPECTED DELIVERIES? OR LEFT OPEN DURING DELIVERIES?

All deliveries are controlled, and verified. Once confirmed vehicles are allowed pass.

ROOF ACCESS

Roof access controlled.

VULNERABILITIES

UNPROTECTED UTILITIES

HVAC/POWER/GAS/WATER/TELECOM

UNRESTRICTED ACCESS TO AREAS ADJACENT TO BUILDING MONITORED OR SURVEILLED?

LOCKDOWN PROCEDURES - DEFEND:

PA SYSTEM/NOTIFICATIONS

CAN ALL STAFF MAKE NOTIFICATIONS?

No PA system available, but this location most employees are spread out. Everbridge ability discussed, and would be ideal to push notifications to all staff. Currently using cell phones to push information out

OFFICES WITH LOCKING DOOR/WINDOWS

CAN THEY BE LOCKED FROM INSIDE?

CAN WINDOWS BE COVERED QUICKLY?

QUICK RELEASE LOCKS ON DOORS AND WINDOWS FOR ESCAPE/EVACUATIONS

Multiple offices inside with locking ability. Multiple exterior doors to be able to quickly exit buildings

SAFE AREAS

BATHROOMS, CLOSETS, MULTIPURPOSE ROOMS, ETC.

ARE THEY ABLE TO SECURE THOSE AREAS?

Open access bathrooms, but multiple areas with locking abilities.

FIRST AID KITS

- TOURNIQUETS
- FIRST AID KITS
- STAFF TRAINED ON FIRST AID
- “STOP THE BLEED” TRAINING FROM DMC - FREE

All building have First Aid Kit. Stop the bleed training explained, and will be looking into getting staff to the training.

RESOURCES FOR RESPONDING OFFICERS

- REMOVABLE FLOOR PLANS AT ALL EXITS/ENTRANCES FOR FIRST RESPONDERS
- MASTER KEY
WHO HAS MASTER KEYS? SHOULD NOT BE PUT SOMEWHERE FOR ACCESS TO ALL.
- KNOX BOX LOCATIONS AND ARE THEY FUNCTIONING?

Removable Floor plans on the major access points. Dispatch has detailed map of all the property, map is also posted inside.

CRISIS RESPONSE BOX

- PERTINENT INFORMATION NEEDED QUICKLY DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS
- EASILY ACCESSIBLE AND IDENTIFIABLE
- ITEMS TO CONSIDER:
 - MAPS
 - BLUE PRINTS
 - Aerial PHOTOGRAPHS
 - EVACUATION ROUTES
 - COPY OF THE SAFETY PLAN
 - CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL
 - PERSONNEL ROSTER
 - BUSS ROUTES AND DRIVERS LIST
 - FIRST AID KIT LOCATIONS

Discussed possibility of getting a folder with all of the above information.
